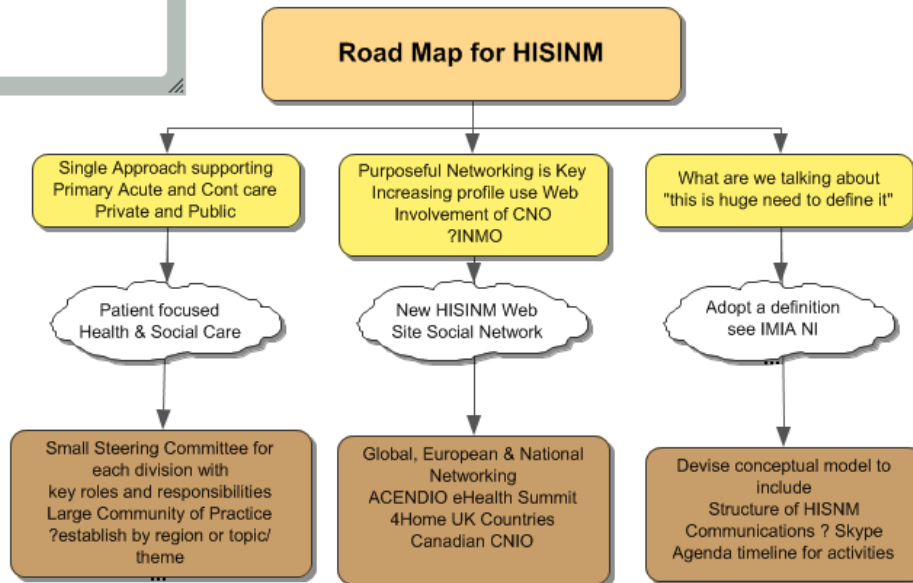
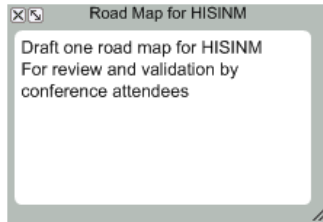

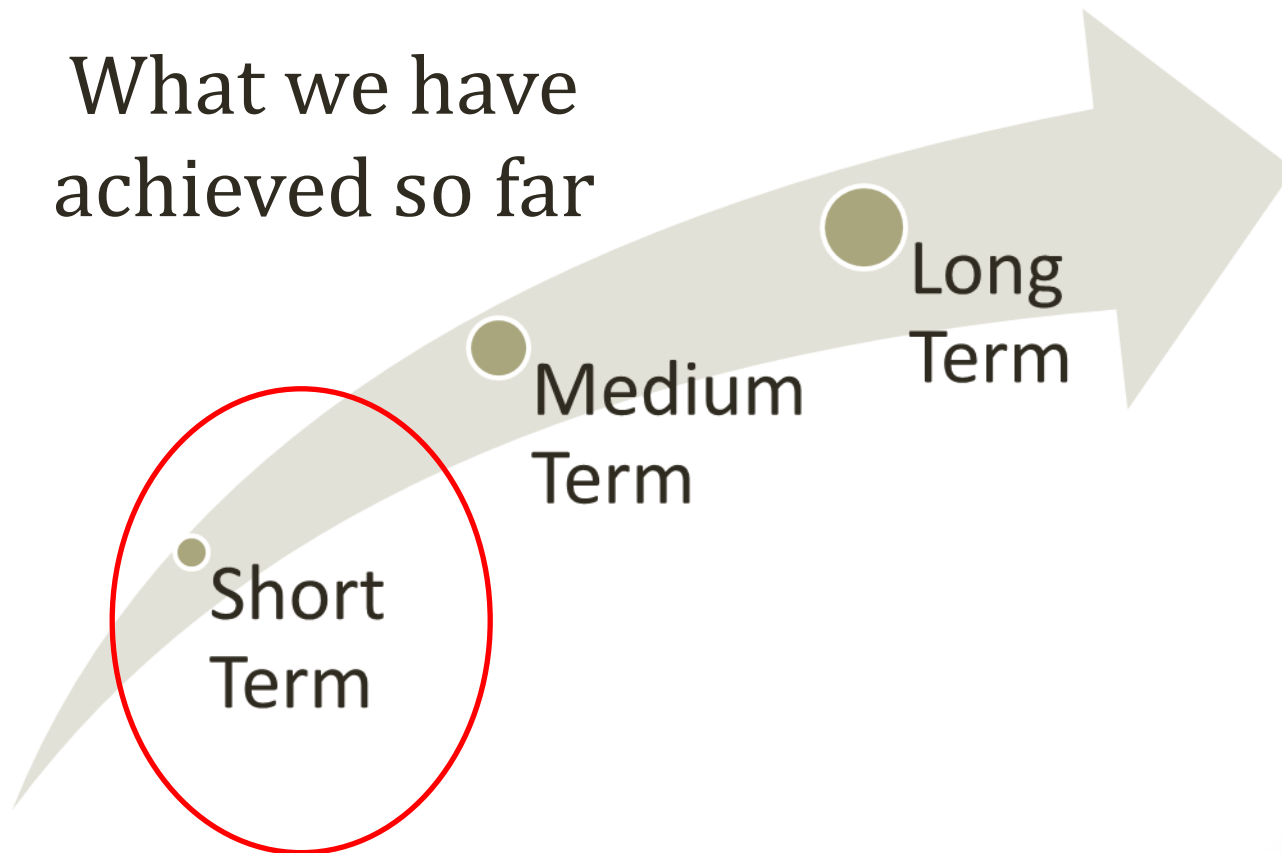
Original Roadmap

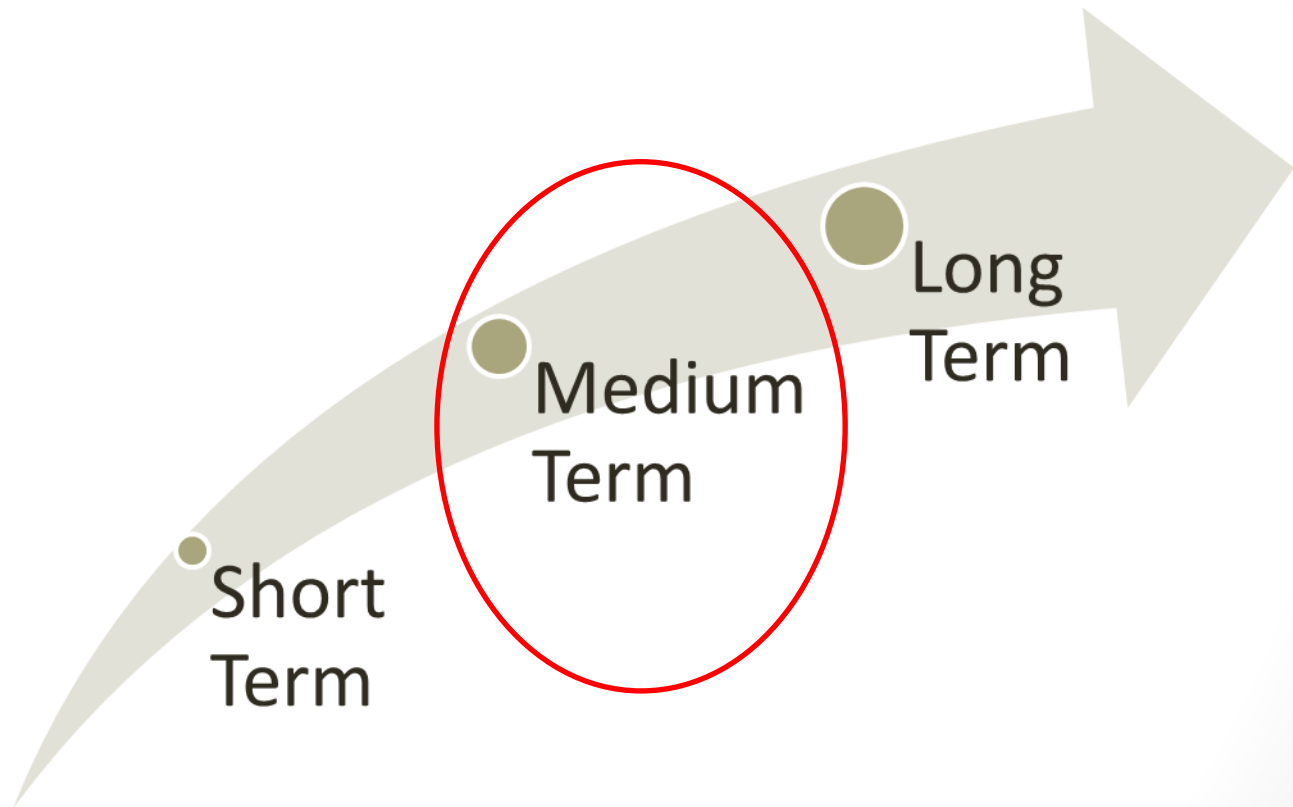
